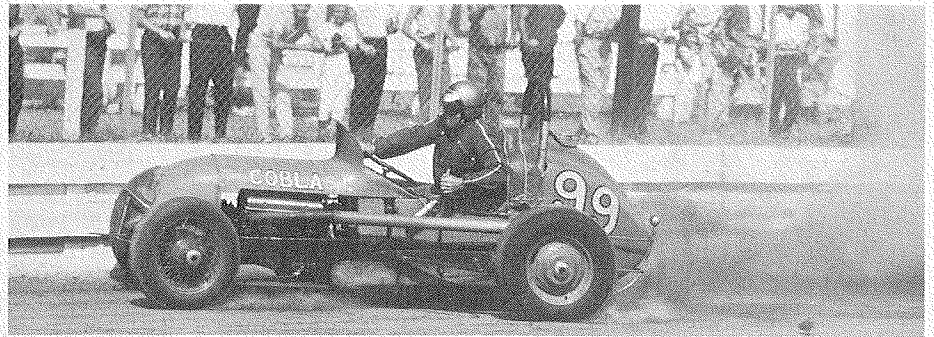

Martin, Don Gillette, Cookie Osterhout and Ron Mack.

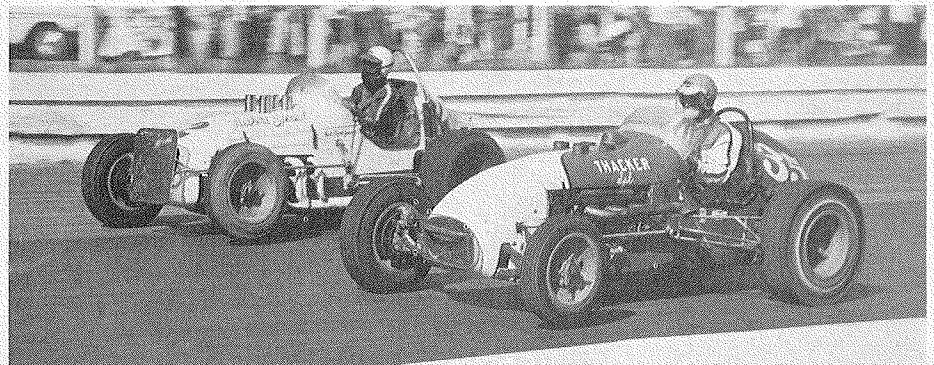

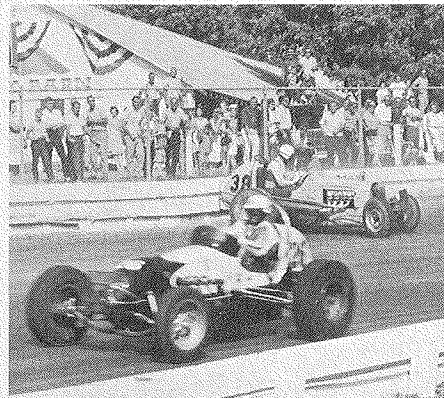
Another perfect day came to a close both weather and race wise as Red Riegel still continued to lead the URC point race despite not finishing today's feature.



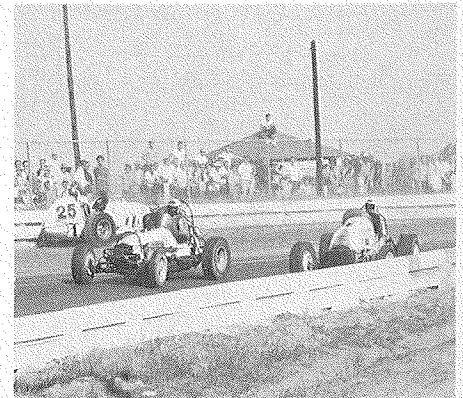
Wimpy Ervin waits until the consolation to get into the boards.
